DEPROCLAMATION OF LAND AS AN ALLUVIAL DIGGING

Under section 25 of the Precious Stones Act, 1964 (Act 73 of 1964), I hereby declare that a portion of the farm Zevenfontein 240 HO, approximately 571,3068 hectares in extent and situated in the District of Bloemhof, Mining District of Klerksdorp, Province of the Transvaal, as shown on a sketch plan copies of which are filed in the office of the Mining Commissioner, Klerksdorp, and the Mining Titles Office, Johannesburg, under RMT R69/91, being land proclaimed as the Zevenfontein Alluvial Digging by Proclamation 81 of 1938, shall be closed and deproclaimed as an alluvial digging for precious stones with effect from the first day after the date of publication of this proclamation in the *Gazette*.

In terms of section 64 (1) of the Precious Stones Act, 1964 (Act 73 of 1964), I hereby declare that Portion 1 and the Remainder of the farm Krone 104 MS, the Remainder of the farm Rugen 105 MS, the farm Drumsheugh 99 MS, the farm Elesger 98 MS, and Portions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and the Remainder of the farm Venetia 103 MS, District of Soutpansberg, Mining District of Pietersburg, Province of the Transvaal, together 3 602,7746 hectares in extent and as shown on a diagram approved by the Surveyor-General under SG No. B 5/1991 on 14 August 1991, copies of which are filed in the office of the Mining Commissioner, Pietersburg, under RMT R52/91, shall be a mining area for precious stones with effect from the date of publication of this proclamation in the *Gazette*.
