NOTICE REGARDING THE AUTHORITY'S PRELIMINARY DECISIONS IN THE CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR FOUR-YEAR COMMUNITY SOUND BROADCASTING LICENCE APPLICATIONS IN GAUTENG PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given in terms of section 41(3) and 41(5) of the Independent broadcasting Authority Act No 153 of 1993 as amended that the following decisions by the Council of the Authority were made in order to properly consider the applications for four-year community sound broadcasting licences in Gauteng Province. These amongst others relate to the frequencies and areas applied for by the applicants listed below:

1. Radio Pretoria

Radio Pretoria should choose either licence area 18 with frequency 104.2MHz or licence area 21 and the allotted frequency 96.8MHz.

2. Radio Goudrif and Radio Springbok

That the two applicants be considered for other published frequencies in the areas they have applied for such as 95.4MHz in area 26 for Radio Goudrif and 102.2 in area 27 for Radio Springbok.

3. Vaal Community Radio

The new application submitted in 2003 not be accepted as it was submitted after the closing date of 20 March 1998 as published in the government gazette no 17998 of May 1997 and that only the one application received before the closing date be considered.

4. Orange Farm Community Radio

That frequency 100.6 MHz which has been published in the frequency plan be availed from licence area 33 to licence area 32 as the frequency 102.2MHz in area 32 would cause unacceptable levels of interference if granted.

5. Radio Pulpit

The applicant should choose a licence area and relevant frequency as advertised in the June 1997 frequency plan. The applicant did not indicate a specific licence area and the frequency applied for was categorised for commercial sound broadcasting services.

6. Radio East Rand

The applicant be considered for frequency 93.9MHz published in the 1997 frequency plan for Gauteng community radio frequency plan for licence area 24 and not 93.8MHz as applied for because 93.8MHz is not available in the 1999 and 2002 frequency plans.

Interested parties are invited to make representations to the Authority within thirty days of the publication of this notice. The closing date for the representations shall therefore be 10 May 2003.
