I, Jeffrey Thamsanqa Radebe, Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, hereby, with effect from 6 August 2012, in terms of –

- (a) section 2(1)(h) of the Magistrates' Courts Act, 1944 (Act No. 32 of 1944), appoint Palm Ridge, in the district of Alberton as a place for the holding of a court and which shall be the seat of the magistracy; and
- (b) section 2(1)(l) of the Magistrates' Courts Act, 1944 (Act No. 32 of 1944), abolish Alberton as a place for holding of a court in the district of Alberton.
