### TRADE MEASURES ACT [CHAPTER 298]

Assizing: Belingwe, Charter, Chilimanzi, Gokwe, Gwelo, Que Que, Selukwe and Shabani Districts

NOTICE is hereby given, in terms of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Trade Measures Act [Chapter 298], that all persons having measuring equipment in use in trade in the Belingwe, Charter, Chilimanzi, Gokwe, Gwelo, Que Que, Selukwe or Shabani districts are required to produce same to an inspector for the purpose of their being assized on or before the 11th June, 1981, at any of the assize stations specified in the Schedule at the appropriate time specified opposite thereto.

may request that such measuring equipment be assized on his premises by forthwith notifying, in writing, the Regional Inspector of Trade Measures, P.O. Box RY 1, Raylton, of the particulars of such measuring equipment and the place where it is ordinarily kept.

Fees to be charged for assizing are prescribed in the Trade Measures (Assize Fees) Regulations, 1974, published in Rhodesia Government Notice 100 of 1974, as amended.

Failure by any person to comply with the provisions of this notice, unless exempted in terms of the Act or regulations made thereunder, renders him liable to prosecution and to the penalties specified in the Act.
