LIQUOR ACT [CHAPTER 289]

Directions on Matters of Policy

THE Minister of Justice, in terms of subsection (1) of section 63 of the Liquor Act [Chapter 289], hereby makes the following directions on matters of policy:—

- 1. An application for the renewal, transfer or removal of a liquor licence should be refused, and an existing liquor licence should be suspended or cancelled, if the licensing authority is satisfied—
 - (a) that the licensee or approved manager, or any person employed by the licensee on the licensed premises, discriminates between persons of different race; or

- (b) that the licensee or approved manager fails to take reasonable steps to prevent objectionable or subversive writing or pictures from appearing on the licensed premises or to remove such writing or pictures once they have occurred; or
- that the licensee or approved manager permits or fails to take reasonable steps to prevent the occurrence of anti-State activity on the licensed premises.
- 2. An application for the issue of a liquor licence should be refused if the licensing authority is satisfied that a contravention of subparagraph (a), (b) or (c) of paragraph 1 is likely to occur.
- 3. In deciding whether a contravention of subparagraph (a), (b) or (c) of paragraph 1 has occurred, or is likely to occur, the licensing authority shall take into account the views of the local authority (as defined in section 2 of the Act) as well as any report submitted by the police, by an inspector of premises or by some other person in terms of subsection (2) of section 91 of the Act.
- 4. An application for the issue, removal, transfer or renewal of a liquor licence should be refused, and an existing liquor licence should be suspended or cancelled, if the relevant local authority recommends such a course of action:

Provided that the licensing authority shall not be bound by the local authority's recommendation where, in the opinion of the licensing authority—

- (a) the recommendation is frivolous or vexatious; or
- (b) the recommendation is based on the financial or commercial interest in the liquor industry of the local authority or one of its members; or
- (c) exceptional circumstances exist.

- 1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.
