These abnormally low water-levels could result in previously safe areas of the lake becoming very shallow, thus increasing the danger to vessels from submerged or partly submerged trees and rocks. All mariners are warned, therefore, that extreme caution should be exercised at all times, and particularly when sailing close to shore.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.
