- 3. Any consumer who contravenes any of the provisions of this scheme, or any other water-rationing scheme in force at the date of such contravention, shall be guilty of an offence; any failure by a consumer to observe the restrictions imposed by such scheme or schemes may result in water supplies being disconnected to the property of such consumer, and, in such event, such consumer shall be liable for a reconnection fee of \$150.

- 1.
