ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Renewal of Road Service Permits

HOLDERS of road service permits which are due to expire on the 31st January, 1985, are reminded that applications for renewal thereof must be lodged, on form R.M.T. 8, with the Controller of Road Motor Transportation, P.O. Box 8332, Causeway, not later than the 1st January, 1985.

Subsection (2) of section 9 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262] provided that the Controller shall not consider any application for the renewal of a road service permit unless it is lodged with him at least 30 days before its date of expiry.

All holders of road service permits which expire in January, 1985, are hereby notified that, in terms of section 8 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262], the holders of such permits are required, when submitting applications for the renewal of their permits, to substantiate the rate of utilization of each permit during the entire period of validity ending in January, 1985. Failure to show that the relevant road service permits were being used for purposes for which such permits were originally issued could result in such permits not being renewed. The provisions of section 12 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262] will be applied in all cases where holders fail to substantiate permit usage.

NATURAL RESOURCES ACT [CHAPTER 150]**Declaration of Zinyama Intensive Conservation Area**

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Natural Resources and Tourism has, in terms of subsection (7) of section 48 of the Natural Resources Act [Chapter 150], declared the area described hereunder, situated in the Bulalima-Mangwe District and shown on Plan ICA/22/80, to be an Intensive Conservation Area and that the area shall be known as the Zinyama Intensive Conservation Area.
