One Hundred and Seventy-Seven State Lottery

NOTICE is hereby given, for general information, that the one hundred and seventy-seven State lottery will be drawn in public, under the direction of the Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development, on December, the 19th, 1986, at 12.30 p.m. in the State Lotteries Hall, Harare. The first prize will be \$100 000.

Conditions for draw

(a) Tickets with counterfoils will be sold at \$5 each.
 (b) Based on the face value of all tickets sold, up to 25 per cent. of the total subscriptions may be reserved for social service, public welfare or relief of distress.

2. The prize-fund will be distributed as follows:

- (a) First—as above, Second—\$20 000, Third—\$10 000.
- (b) The remainder will be distributed in smaller ordinary prizes and consolation prizes.
- (c) There will be no free tickets, no introducers' prizes, no introducers' jackpot prizes and no double and treble prizes.
- (d) If, in the opinion of the Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development, the prize-fund is insufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above will be reduced as directed by the Minister.

3. The draw

- (a) The number of all tickets sold will participate in the draw for all prizes.
- (b) If the Director is satisfied that a fault has occurred in the drawing of a prize-number a "no draw" shall be announced, and the prize shall be drawn again. A ball jamming when coming out of a drum will not in itself be considered as a fault. Examples of faults are—
 - (i) one or more balls appearing before control-button is pressed;
 - (ii) control-button pressed before all balls are in the drums.
- (c) Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], when a prize-number has been passed and recorded, no subsequent claim that a "no draw" should have been announced will be considered.
- (d) Only one prize can be won by one ticket-number (section 2 above). If a ticket is drawn, the prize is payable to the party whose name appears on the counterfoil. No trading in tickets will be recognized by the State Lottery. If the number drawn represents an unsold ticket, a "no draw" will be announced, and the prize will be drawn again. If the number drawn for a bigger prize represents a number of a ticket which has already won a smaller prize, the bigger prize will be payable.
- (e) Only the lucky names and towns of the purchasers of winning tickets will be announced. Names are not announced or published.
- 4. Payment of prizes
 - (a) All cash prizes are free from taxation by the Government, and are payable, in full, by cheque.

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and (a)

the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy, published by the Department of Printing and Stationery; (b)

which two booklets are intended for complemental use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the Gazette.

.1. (1) Other than by prior arrangement, only original typing is accepted.

(2) Carbon-copies are not normally acceptable, other than in cases where the original typing has to be legally retained elsewhere, as, for example, in the case of a proclamation.
