Application for Exclusive Prospecting Order: Masvingo Mining District

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsection (4) of section 88 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], that Rio Tinto Zimbabwe Limited has applied to the Mining Affairs Board for an exclusive prospecting order, over the area described hereunder, in the Masvingo mining district, in relation to maps references Fort Victoria 2030 B2 of the Third Edition and Zimbabwe 2030 B4 of the Second Edition, of the scale 1:50 000, produced by the Surveyor-General.

Description of area

An area of approximately 104 000 hectares in the Masvingo mining district and bounded by a line commencing at a point 5 kilometres south of where the Masvingo-Great Zimbabwe Ruins Road crosses the Reserved Area 191 Pipe Line (grid reference TN743739); thence for a distance of approximately 1,5 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 179° to the point where the Masvingo-Great Zimbabwe Ruins Road and the reserved Town Lands of Flosk Plots meet (grid reference TN744724); thence for a distance of approximately 1,0 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 24° to a point where the Reserved Area 191 Pipe Line meets the boundary of Junction Farm, Riverside Farm and Town Lands Reserved Area (grid reference TN748733); thence for a distance of approximately 3,8 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 109° to the peak of a hill (grid reference TN784720); thence for a distance of approximately 4,5 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 167° to the point where the gravel road crosses an unnamed stream (grid reference TN794677); thence for a distance of approximately 11,5 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 208° to the northern peak of Barapate Hill (grid reference TN741576); thence for a distance of approximately 6,5 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 294° to the confluence of two unnamed streams (grid reference TN681603); thence for a distance of approximately 15,2 kilometres on a true bearing of approximately 25° to the starting-point.

The applicant wishes to prospect for gold and associated base minerals within the area which has been reserved against prospecting pending determination of this application. Prospecting authority is not sought upon registered base mineral blocks within the reservation.
