ROAD MOTOR TRANSPORTATION ACT [CHAPTER 262]

Renewal of Road Service Permits

HOLDERS of road service permits which are due to expire on the 30th September, 1989, are reminded that applications for renewal thereof must be lodged, on form R.M.T. 8, with the Controller of Road Motor Transportation, P.O. Box 8332, Causeway, not later than 31st August, 1989.

Subsection (2) of section 9 of the Road Motor Transpotation Act [Chapter 262] provides that the Controller shall not consider any application for the renewal of a road service permit unless it is lodged with him at least 30 days before its date of expiry.

All holders of road service permits which expire in September, 1989, are hereby notified that, in terms of section 8 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262], the holders of such permits are required, when submitting applications for the renewal of their permits, to substantiate the rate of utilization of each permit during the entire period of validity ending in September, 1989. Failure to show that the relevant road service permits were being used for purposes for which such permits were originally issued could result in such permits not being renewed. The provisions of section 12 of the Road Motor Transportation Act [Chapter 262] will be applied in all cases where holders fail to substantiate permit usage.
