**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS AND PROHIBITION OF BUSINESS
 ACT [CHAPTER 292]**

Declaration of Public Holiday and Prohibition of Business

HIS Excellency the President hereby, in terms of sections 2 and 3 of the Public Holidays and Prohibition of Business Act [Chapter 292], declares that—

- (a) Monday the 5th March, 1990, shall be a public holiday; and
- (b) no business shall be conducted on the 5th March, 1990, which could not be conducted in terms of any agreement, determination or employment regulation in force in terms of the Labour Relations Act, 1985, were the 5th March, 1990, an industrial holiday for the purposes thereof; and
- (c) any business which is conducted on the 5th March, 1990, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (b) shall be conducted subject to any agreement, determination or employment regulation in force in terms of the Labour Relations Act, 1985, as if the 5th March, 1990, were an industrial holiday for the purpose thereof.
