MINES AND MINERALS ACT [CHAPTER 165]

Exclusive Prospecting Order No. 684: Gweru Mining District

THE following order is published in terms of subsection (2) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165]:—

"I, Jonas Christian Andersen, Minister of Mines, with the approval of the President, hereby, in terms of subsection (1) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], make an exclusive prospecting order, in favour of Prospecting Ventures Limited over the area described hereunder, in the Gweru mining district, in relation to maps referenced Gweru Dam, 1929D4 Donga 1930C3, Selukwe 1930C1, all of the Third Edition, and of the scale 1:50 000, produced by the Surveyor-General, subject to the following conditions—

- (a) the order is made in respect of nickel, cobalt, chromite and platinum group elements, gold and silver;
(b) the concession holder shall carry out prospecting operations in a manner satisfactory to the Minister of Mines.

Prospecting Ventures Limited is authorized, in terms of subsection (4) of section 94 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], to prospect on all registered base mineral blocks which were not being worked or developed on the 12th June, 1989, being the date of the lodging for this order.

Description of area

An area of approximately 18 498 hectares, situated in the Gweru mining district and bounded by a line commencing at the bridge over the Umtebekwa River (grid reference 36KSP919235) (which is approximately 6 kilometres east of Shurugwi); thence proceeding on a true bearing of approximately 358° 45' for a distance of approximately 11,5 kilometres to the junction of two tracks (grid reference 36KSP91443495); thence on a true bearing of approximately 36° for a distance of approximately 6,5 kilometres to a bridge over the Umtebekwa River (grid reference 36KSP95204025); thence on a true bearing of approximately 102° 45' for a distance of approximately 3,25 kilometres to the junction of two tracks (grid reference 36KSP98403960); thence on a true bearing of approximately 192° 30' for a distance of approximately 27,9 kilometres to the junction of two tracks (grid reference 36KSP2711225); thence on a true bearing of approximately 208° 30' for a distance of approximately 19,65 kilometres to the junction of two tracks (grid reference 35KPH11859487); thence on a true bearing of approximately 285° for a distance of approximately 1,15 kilometres to the junction of two tracks (grid reference 35KHP10769520); thence on a true bearing of approximately 05° 30' for a distance of approximately 7,24 kilometres to where a track crosses a stream (grid reference 35KRR1155240); thence on a true bearing of approximately 18° for a distance of approximately 3,45 kilometres to a major road bridge over the Umtebekwa River (grid reference 35KRR112660570); thence on a true bearing of approximately 25° 30' for a distance of approximately 19,3 kilometres to the starting point.
