LABOUR RELATIONS ACT, 1985

Order to Rectify an Unfair Labour Practice

I, IGNATIUS TAKAIDZA CHIGWENDERE, being Chairman of the Labour Relations Board, having taken cognisance of the matter between B and S Trucks (Pvt.) Ltd., Fort Street, Bulawayo and L. Vitalis, of 6016, Luveve 5, P.O. Luveve, Bulawayo, determined by Acting Regional Hearing Officer Mehlo, on the 29th December, 1989, have found B and S Trucks (Pvt.) Limited guilty of an Unfair Labour Practice in terms of section 8 of the Act, as read with provisions of Statutory Instrument 368 of 1985. The company by noting an appeal out of time is in breach of subsection (1) of section 18 and the Regional Hearing Officer has no right to condone a breach of the provision.

The Board cannot condone a breach of the law therefore orders that B and S Trucks (Pvt.) Ltd. comply with the Regional Hearing Officer's determination with immediate effect.

Description	Water ration
1. All houses and flats	660 litres per day.
2. Churches, sports clubs, multi-purpose buildings incorporating flats, offices and/or shops	80% of 6 months average consumption ending 30th November, 1990.
3. Restaurants and industrial consumers	90% of 6 months average consumption ending 30th November, 1990.
4. Schools, colleges and other institutions	80% of the average consumption for the months during which they were in occupation during 1990.
5. Livestock (only within municipal area)	40 litres per day per horse or head of cattle stabled in premises registered for a specific number of animals.
6. Hospitals and hotels	Exempted from rationing but use of hosepipes totally banned. To impose own rationing and situation to be monitored.
7. Mzinyathini irrigation scheme	50% of entitlement.

The Council has further resolved that any consumers who exceed their ration shall pay a surcharge of \$5 (five dollars) per kilolitre on the excess consumption.

A higher surcharge is to be imposed for the second and subsequent violations, the details of which will be announced in due course.

Note:

(a) The ration will be enforced on the basis of the meter-reading period, i.e., the period between consecutive meter readings. This means that where meters are read every two months, double the monthly ration will be permitted for the two months period before a surcharge is imposed based on the ACTUAL reading for the period. In the case of the western suburbs where meters are read quarterly a similar principal will apply over a three months period.

(b) The Council also resolved that its previous resolution (18th July, 1990), relating to the prohibition of the use of hosepipes for watering purposes of any kind whatsoever or the washing or cleansing of any kind whatsoever by hosepipe between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. every day, be re-affirmed. Provided that the prohibition shall not apply where the water supply is a well, a borehole or reclaimed water. This means that, with the exception of hotels and hospitals, hosepipes may be used between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. provided the consumer's ration is not exceeded. The previous penalties for the illegal use of hosepipes will remain in force.

The success of the rationing scheme will depend on the positive co-operation of the public in the conservation of water. The support of the public is therefore earnestly sought.

(3) Computer print-outs are not accepted automatically, as discussion may be necessary with regard to the extra time and costs involved.

2. (1) All copy must be clear and legible, and there must be double or one and a half spacing between the lines.

(2) Any corrections or alterations made by the originator, must be clearly effected in blue or black ink, using editorial marks—not proof-reader's marks:

Provided that any copy containing extensive alterations will be rejected.

3. (1) Copy must appear on one side only of each sheet of paper.

(2) Except as is provided in subsection (2) of section 8, paper must not exceed 210 millimetres in width.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance, 7, 7b, 8, *et cetera*.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

- (a) exceed 10 pages of double-spaced typing on size A4 paper; or
- (b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

it will be classed as "lengthy" copy and will be required to be submitted not less than 21 days before the date of closing for the *Gazette* in which it is to be published.

(2) Lengthy copy may be accepted at less than 21 days' notice if—

- (a) the work involved is of a straight forward and non tabular nature; and
- (b) the total volume of work on hand for the time being permits its acceptance.

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in these conditions, any copy—

- (a) which is of national importance, and which is originated as a matter of urgent necessity, may, by prior arrangement, be accepted late for the current week;
- (b) may, due to shortage of staff or to technical considerations, be delayed until conditions permit its processing.

7. Copy must not be submitted as part of a letter or a requisition. It must appear on a separate sheet of paper, on which there is no instruction or other extraneous matter.

8. (1) In cases where notices have to be published in tabular form, copy must be drafted *exactly* as it is to appear. If printed forms for any such notices are unavailable, advertisers must prepare their own forms. While it is not necessary to include the preamble, the box-headings must be there, and, where applicable, the number of the form; for example, "Insolvency Regulations—Form 3".

(2) In the case of copy for tabular notices, the provision of subsection (2) of section 3 does not apply.

9. Copy for all advertisements, whether sent by post or delivered by hand, must be accompanied by a requisition or a letter which clearly sets out—

- (a) the name and address of the advertiser; and
- (b) the debtor's code-number, if any; and
- (c) the required date or dates of publication.

10. (1) If a typographical error occurs in the *Gazette*, it is rectified as soon as possible by a correcting notice without charge to the ministry or department concerned, subject to the following conditions—

- (a) that such error is reported to the editor within three months from the date of publication; and
- (b) that the relevant copy, upon re-examination, is proved to be abundantly clear; and
- (c) that the correction of such error is legally necessary;

(2) If a drafting error is not detected before publication, the originating ministry or department is required to draft its own correcting notice, take it to the Attorney-General for vetting, and pay for such notice to be published.

(3) For the removal of doubt—

- (a) a typographical error is made by a typographer;
- (b) a typist's error is classed as a drafting error by reason of the fact that the officer responsible for drafting failed to check the typist's work.
