ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1976

Fixing of Fees

Two Hundred and Third Lottery: Units One, Two, Three and Four

NOTICE is hereby given for general information, that units one, two, three and four of the two hundred and third lottery will be drawn in public under the direction of the Minister of Finance at the venues stated below—

Unit one—14th May, 1993—12.30 p.m.—State Lottery Hall, Harare.

Unit two—11th June, 1993—12.30 p.m.—Main City Hall, Bulawayo.

Unit three—9th July, 1993—12.30 p.m.—State Lottery Hall, Harare.

Unit four—6th August, 1993—12.30 p.m.—State Lottery Hall, Harare.

The first prize will be \$100 000,00 in all units.

Conditions for each unit

1.—

- tickets with counterfoils will be sold at \$2 each.
- based on the face value of all tickets sold or issued free, up to 25 per cent. of the total subscription may be reserved for Social Services, Public Welfare or relief of distress.

2. Prizes

The prize fund will be distributed as follows—

- Ordinary prizes: first, as above, second, \$30 000, third, \$15 000. Introducers: \$1 000; \$500; \$250.
- The remainder of the prize-money will be distributed in smaller ordinary, introducers, introducers' jackpot and consolation prizes. If, in the opinion of the Minister, the prize-fund is insufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above will be reduced as directed by that Minister.
- Two introducers' jackpot prizes of \$1 000,00 each. Only tickets issued against one written order of 12 tickets or more in one unit are eligible to win these prizes, provided such written order has been compiled at one and the same time. Prizes not won will be carried forward and used to increase the jackpot prizes in the following unit. These prizes will be drawn after the draw for ordinary prizes has been completed. There will be no double or treble prizes.

3. Double and treble prizes

Any ordinary lottery prize of \$200 or less, won by a lottery ticket will be (i) *doubled* if the prize-winner sends in with his prize ticket, three additional lottery tickets in the same unit; or (ii) *trebled* if the prize-winner sends in with his prize-ticket, seven additional lottery tickets in the same unit, provided that in order to qualify for the double and treble prizes, the counterfoils of all tickets submitted must have exactly the same name and address as that found on the counterfoil of the prize-winning

ticket. (Nearly the same is not sufficient). To give examples of possible differences in counterfoils: "J. Jones, John Jones and Mr. J. Jones"; "Byo and Bulawayo"—"Rd. and Road"—"Box and P.O. Box". Multiple prizes do not apply to introducers' prizes and consolation prizes.

4. The draw

- (a) The number of all tickets sold will participate in the draw for all prizes.
- (b) If the Director is satisfied that a fault has occurred in the drawing of a prize-number, a "no draw" shall be announced and the prize shall be drawn again. A ball jamming when coming out of a drum will not in itself be considered as a fault. Examples of faults—
 - (i) one or more balls appearing before the control button is pressed;
 - (ii) control button pressed before all balls are in the drums.
- (c) Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], when a prize-number has been passed and recorded, no subsequent claim that a "no draw" should have been announced will be considered.
- (d) Only one ordinary prize can be won by one ticket number (clause 2 above). If a ticket is drawn, the prize is payable to the party whose name appears on the counterfoil. No trading in tickets will be recognized by the State Lottery. If the number drawn represents an unsold ticket, a "no draw" will be announced and the prize will be drawn again. If the number drawn for a higher prize represents a number of a ticket which has already won a smaller prize, the bigger prize will be payable. Except as provided by subclause (iii) of 2 above. Prizes will be drawn in order of value.
- (e) Only lucky names and towns of the purchasers of winning tickets will be announced, names are not announced or published. (This does not apply to winners of prizes drawn to promote the Lottery.)

5. Payment of prizes

- (a) All cash prizes are free from taxation by the Government and are payable in full cheque.
- (b) Tickets are official receipts in themselves and prizes will be paid out on production of the winning ticket. The Minister may authorize payment of a prize won by a lottery ticket without production of the ticket.
- (c) If a syndicate wins a prize, it must nominate one or two members to whom the cheque is to be made payable on behalf of the syndicate.

6. Subject to the provisions of the State Lotteries Act [Chapter 317], no responsibility will attach to the Minister of Finance, or Director or Trustees of the State Lotteries on account of the illegibility of counterfoils, errors or omissions on the part of the ticket-sellers, purchasers, press or printers or on account of loss or theft of a ticket.

7. The financial statement and prize-list will be published in *The Herald*, *Harare* and *The Chronicle*, Bulawayo after the draw. Results sheets may be obtained from official ticket-sellers or the Director, and, on request, will be posted to any subscribers who gives an address outside Zimbabwe.

Conditions for Acceptance of Copy

FAILURE to comply with any of the following conditions will result in the rejection of copy, and no responsibility can be accepted if such rejection should affect any date contained in such copy or any requirement of publication on a specific date.

Persons drafting any kind of notices are strongly advised to follow the guidance offered in—

- (a) the Instructions Relating to the Drafting and Typing of Legislation (Attorney-General's Circular 1 of 1978); and
- (b) the Manual of Style for the Drafting and Preparation of Copy published by the Department of Printing and Stationery;

which two booklets are intended for complementary use.

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the *Gazette* itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the *Gazette*.

1. (1) Other than by prior arrangements, only original typing is accepted.

(3) If copy comprises two or more sheets of paper, all sheets must be numbered consecutively, in arabic figures, preferably in the top right-hand corner.

(4) Where any matter is added after the copy has been prepared, and such additional matter results in one or more sheets being inserted between those already numbered, all sheets must be renumbered from there onwards—not, for instance 7, 7b, 8, *et cetera*.

4. Photographic copy or copy produced on a duplicating-machine may be accepted if it is abundantly clear.

5. (1) Should any copy—

- (a) exceed 10 pages of double-spaced typing on size A4 paper; or

(b) contain tabular or other matter which involves complicated setting;

SHERIFF'S SALES

Conditions of sale

- In terms of the rules of court, any person having an interest in the sale may, within seven days of the Sheriff having declared the highest bidder to be the purchaser, apply to the High Court to have it set aside on the grounds that the sale was improperly conducted or the property was sold for an unreasonably low sum, or any other good ground.
- In the event of no application being made within the said period of seven days, the Sheriff shall confirm the sale.
- During the auction, should any dispute arise as to any bid the property will be put up for sale again.
- The right is reserved to the auctioneer of regulating or refusing any bid.
- The sale shall be for cash and, in addition, the purchaser shall pay—
 - the auctioneer's commission; and
 - the costs of transfer, including conveyancer's charges, stamp-duty and any other fees; and
 - all arrear rates and charges, and any other expenses necessary to complete the transfer.
- Immediately after conclusion of the auction, the highest bidder shall, unless other arrangements are made with the auctioneer, deposit with the auctioneer an amount sufficient to cover the auctioneer's commission, and either—
 - advise the Commissioner appointed by the Sheriff, attending the sale, of the manner in which he intends to make payment of the purchase-price and other costs and charges in terms of these conditions, and satisfy the Commissioner as to his bona fides and ability to meet his obligations; or
 - effect payment to the Commissioner of the whole of the purchase-price in cash or by cheque or bank draft drawn to the order of the Sheriff.
- The purchase-money, if not paid in full to the Commissioner at the conclusion of the auction, shall be paid on or before the registration of the transfer of the property into the name of the purchaser, unless the Sheriff approves other arrangements for discharging the amount due by the purchaser.
