### CONSTITUTION OF ZIMBABWE

#### Appointment of Delimitation Commission .

IT is hereby notified that His Excellency the President, in terms of subsection (1) of section 59 of the Constitution, has appointed a Delimitation Commission consisting of the following persons:—

- (a) The Honourable Mr. Justice Wilson Runyararo Sandura, who shall be the chairman of the Commission;
- (b) Dr. Job M. Whabira;
- (c) Mr. Abdullah Kassim;
- (d) Mr. Michael Ndubiwa.

Members of the Commission will hold office until the Commission has presented its report and made a final decision on any matter which His Excellency the President may have referred back to it in terms of subsection (6) of section 60 of the Constitution.

### ELECTORAL ACT, 1990

#### Vacancy: Membership of Parliament

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsection (2) of section 30 of the Electoral Act, 1990, that, in the opinion of the Speaker of Parliament, a vacancy exists in the membership of Parliament due to the conviction and sentence of Mr. Ben Moyo, Member of Parliament for Zengeza, to five years' imprisonment with labour.

In terms of section 42 of the Constitution, the seat of a Member of Parliament who is convicted of a criminal offence and sentenced to imprisonment for a period of six months or more shall become vacant.
