Exclusive Prospecting Order No. 1047: Bulawayo Mining District

THE following order is published in terms of subsection (2) of section 92 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165]:—

"I, Eddison Jonas Mudadirwa Zvobgo, Minister of Mines, with the approval of the President, hereby, in terms of subsection (1) of section 92 of Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 165], make an exclusive prospecting order, in favour of Z.M.D.C. over the area described hereunder, in the Bulawayo mining district, in relation to maps references Bulawayo SF-35-4 of the Second Edition, and of the Scale 1: 250 000, produced by the Surveyor-General, subject to the following conditions:—

In these conditions, other than where a particular kind of copy is specified, "copy" means copy for all matter contained in the Gazette itself and for subsidiary legislation issued as supplements to the Gazette.

- 1. (1) Other than by prior arrangements, only original typing is accepted.
