If, in the opinion of the Minister, the prize-fund is sufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above will be reduced as directed by that Minister.

(iii) *Two introducers' jackpot prizes of \$1 000,00 each*

3. *Double and treble prizes*
