- (d) If in the opinion of the Minister of Finance, the prize-fund is insufficient for the purpose, the amounts of the first three prizes listed above will be reduced as directed by that Minister.

3. The draw

- (a) The number of all tickets sold will participate in the draw for all prizes.
- (b) If the Director is satisfied that a fault has occurred in the drawing of a prize-number, a "NO DRAW" shall be announced and the prize shall be drawn again. A ball jamming when coming out of a drum will not in itself be considered as a fault. Examples of the faults—
