Bulawayo Mining District

IT is hereby notified, in terms of subsection (4) of section 87 of the Mines and Minerals Act [Chapter 21:05], that Mapkush (Private) Limited has applied to the Mining Affairs Board for an exclusive prospecting order, over the area described hereunder, in the Bulawayo mining district, in relation to map reference Plumtree SF-35-3 of the Second Edition and of the Scale 1:250 000, produced by the Surveyor-General.

*Description of area*

An area of approximately 32 650 hectares in extent, situated in the Bulawayo mining district, and bounded by a line commencing at a point which is approximately 11 kilometres south-east of Empandeni Mission (grid reference 35KPG000000); thence proceeding on a true bearing of approximately 90° for a distance of approximately 15 kilometres to a point (grid reference 35KPG150000); thence on a true bearing of approximately 180° for a distance of approximately 21,4 kilometres to a point (grid reference 35KPG150785); thence on a true bearing of approximately 274° for a distance of approximately 15,5 kilometres to a point (grid reference 35KNG995795); thence on a true bearing of approximately 01° for a distance of approximately 21 kilometres to the starting point.

The applicant intends to prospect for gold, silver, beryllium, cobalt, copper, iron, lithium, nickel, niobium, osmium, lead, palladium, platinum, rhodium, tantalum and zinc within the area which has been reserved against prospecting pending determination of this application. Prospecting authority is sought upon registered base mineral blocks within the reservation.

9. Copy for all advertisements, whether sent by post or delivered by hand, must be accompanied by a requisition, or a letter which clearly sets out—

- (a) the name and address of the advertiser; and
- (b) the debtor's code number, if any; and
- (c) the required date or dates of publication.

10. If a typographical error occurs in the *Gazette*, it is rectified as soon as possible by a correcting notice without charge to the ministry or department concerned, subject to the following conditions—

- (a) that such error is reported to the editor within three months from the date of publication; and
- (b) that the relevant copy, upon re-examination, is proved to be abundantly clear; and
- (c) that the correction of such error is legally necessary.

(2) If a drafting error is not detected before publication, the originating ministry or department is required to draft its own correcting notice, take it to the Attorney-General for vetting and pay for such notice to be published.

(3) For the removal of doubt—

- (a) a typographical error is made by a typographer;
- (b) a typist's error is classed as a drafting error by reason of the fact that the officer responsible for drafting failed to check the typist's work.
