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Collective Bargaining Agreement: Clothing Industry (Capping  
of Continuous Renewal of Fixed-term Contracts in the Clothing  
Industry, 2020

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Public Service, Labour and Social Welfare has, in terms of section 80 of the Labour Act [*Chapter 28:01*], published the Collective Bargaining Agreement set out in the Schedule which has been registered in terms of section 79 of the Act.

*Title*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Collective Bargaining Agreement: Clothing Industry (Capping of Continuous Renewal of Fixed-term Contracts in the Clothing Industry), 2020.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Collective Bargaining Agreement—

“clothing industry” means the industry as defined in section 4 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement: Clothing Industry, published in Statutory Instrument 1 of 1999.

*Application*

3. (1) These regulations shall apply to the Clothing Industry only and shall come into force on the date of publication (hereinafter referred to as the “effective date”).

(2) These regulations shall be binding on employers and employees in the clothing sector starting on the effective date.

*Limitation of continuous renewal of fixed-term contracts*

4. A contract of fixed duration shall be deemed to be on a contract without limitation of time upon the expiry of a continuous period of service of two years.

Broadcasting Services (Licensing and Content) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 2020 (No. 5)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Information, Publicity and Broadcasting Services has, in terms of section 46 of the Broadcasting Services Act [Chapter 12:06], approved the following regulations made by the Broadcasting Authority of Zimbabwe Board: —
